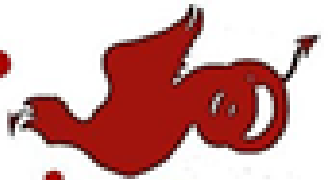

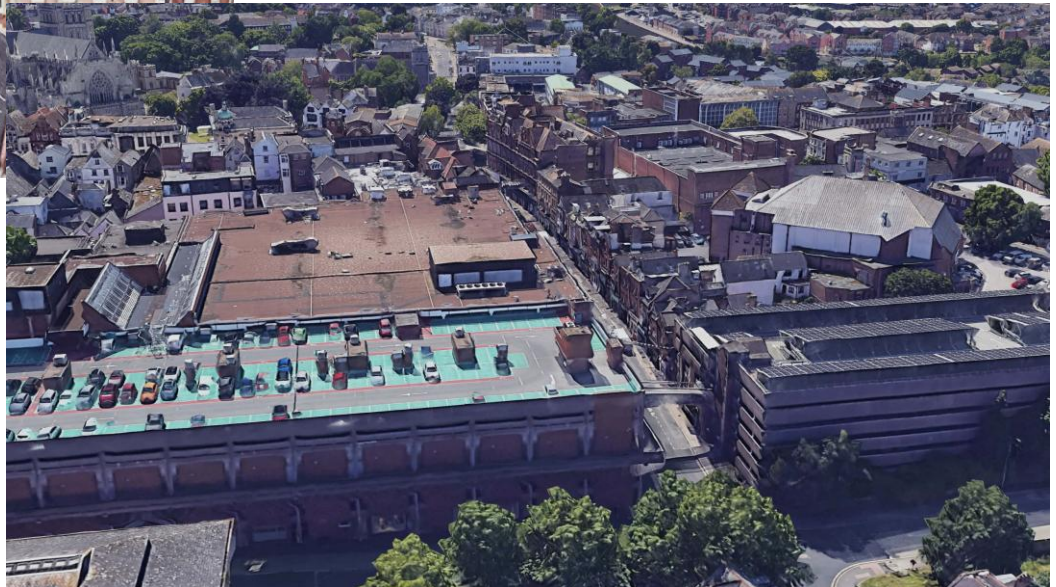

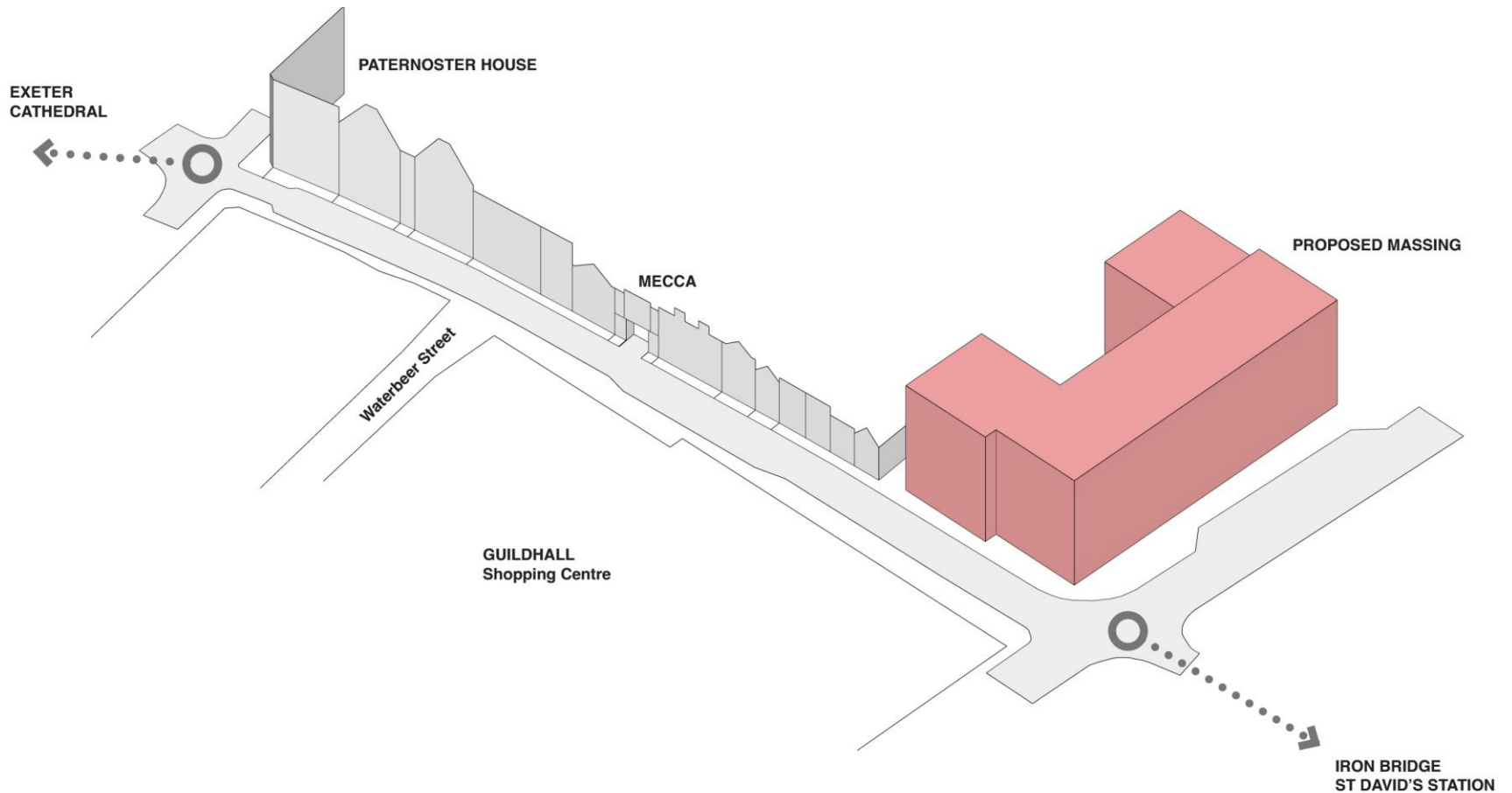

Schematic sketch west side

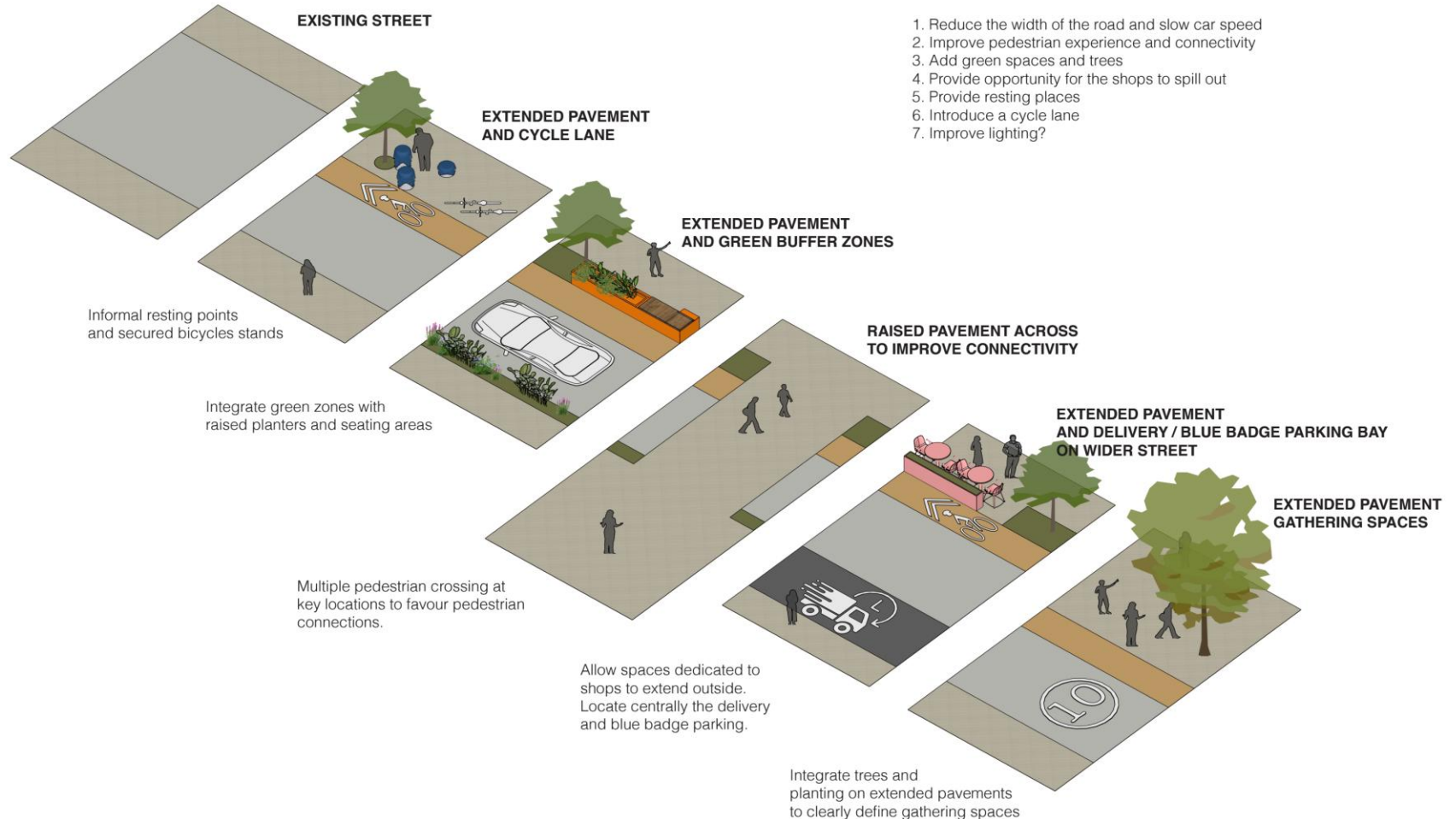

NORTH STREET IMPROVEMENT VISION PRINCIPLES FOR A HAPPY STREET

1. Reduce the width of the road and slow car speed
2. Improve pedestrian experience and connectivity
3. Add green spaces and trees
4. Provide opportunity for the shops to spill out
5. Provide resting places
6. Introduce a cycle lane
7. Improve lighting?
